Prepares drawings and cross sections of maintenance and construction projects. Performs related work as assigned with minimum supervision. Position involves performing multiple tasks, meeting deadlines, and occasionally working extended hours. Prepares or completes various forms, reports, correspondence, and other documentation, including Road Widening Plans, Culvert Plans, project drawings, project files, etc.; compiles data for further processing or for use in preparation of department reports; and maintains computerized and/or hardcopy records.
